

Resolution # 8 Adopted by the Diocesan Convention of the Episcopal Diocese of Alabama at the 177th Diocesan Convention

BE IT RESOLVED that the 177th Annual Episcopal Diocesan Convention of the Diocese of Alabama urges Governor Bob Riley to declare an immediate moratorium on all death penalty executions pending action by the Alabama Legislature;

BE IT RESOLVED that the 177th Annual Episcopal Diocesan Convention of the Diocese of Alabama urge Governor Bob Riley to encourage, support, and pledge upon passage to sign into law Senate Bill 25 providing for a moratorium on all death penalty executions;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 177th Annual Episcopal Diocesan Convention of the Diocese of Alabama urge Governor Bob Riley to encourage, support, and pledge upon passage to sign into law Senate Bill 46 providing for DNA testing;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 177th Annual Episcopal Diocesan Convention of the Diocese of Alabama urge the Alabama Legislature to pass Senate Bill 25, providing for a moratorium on all death penalty executions, during this session of the Alabama Legislature;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 177th Annual Episcopal Diocesan Convention of the Diocese of Alabama urge the Alabama Legislature to pass Senate Bill 46, providing for DNA testing, during this session of the Alabama Legislature;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that parish vestries of the Diocese of Alabama prayerfully consider, individually, adopting resolutions in support of the passage and signing into law Senate Bill 25 providing for a moratorium on all death penalty executions and Senate Bill 46 providing for DNA testing; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution and any individual Parish resolutions be forwarded to Governor Bob Riley and the Alabama Legislature.
